



A University of Houston Study of the writings of the founding fathers boiled down thousands of writings into the 1054 most influential.


They then analyzed those writings and found that 34% of the quotes were directly from the Bible, and 60% of the quotes were of other men who were quoting the Bible.


Therefore, 94% of the most important statements by the founding fathers had their roots in scripture.



The Convention made a motion to act on Franklin's remarks

It was decided that they would gather a few days later on July 4th for a Sermon and prayer

Thereafter, when the Convention resumed there were daily prayers at the beginning of the day's meetings

This provided the breakthrough ideas and cordiality that allowed the Constitution to be finished and agreed upon

It also established the practice that is still followed today of Congress opening in prayer.

































### Features That "Bind Down" the Federal Government

The First Amendment

#### Huge Implications! • If Congress is prohibited from

making law,

- · This takes out the whole federal government's power to have any say in these areas
- · If no law, there is no enforcement power by President
- · And no power for the Supreme Court to rule on



### Big idea

- Congress would not establish a <u>national</u> <u>denomination or</u> <u>church</u>
- Congress would not establish a <u>state</u> <u>controlled church</u>




This meant that there was all kind of religious freedom in the public domain ....

- <u>Congress could</u> have prayer, have chaplains, have Bible Studies, have a church service in the capital (1800s), print Morals and Teaching of Jesus (1910)
- Presidents could call for prayer, talk about God, call the nation to follow God, talk about biblical principles in govt
- <u>Courts could</u> have prayer, appeal to the 10 commandments, look to the Bible for principles

### Jesus and Civil Government



<u>Caesar</u> – told the public that Caesar is not God <u>Herod</u> – "a fox" - conniving and deceitful <u>Pilate</u> - has no authority except what God gave him <u>Judges</u> – criticized as being unrighteous – feared neither God nor man

Endorsed someone who actively criticized a civil leader – John the Baptist, - "greatest born of woman"

People using authority for ill should be judged- if anyone causes this little one to sin - "better to have a millstone tied around their neck..."


